Supported Community Living

The program serves individuals with cognitive disability who need supports to live in the community fully.

- 1. Age Range: from 18 and above and under 50.
- 2. Service model: group home (under six persons) and community-based services.

Activity Centers

St. Theresa's runs two activity centers to support the people in the local community with various activities, including intergenerational activities.

Early Intervention

The early intervention teachers, social workers and therapists of our center bring services into the natural learning environment of infants and toddlers (such as homes and kindergartens) so as to help them grow like their peers.



- 1. Age Range: infants and toddlers under the age of three, who are developmentally at risk, delayed or disabled.
- Major Service model: Family-centered / home-based services
- 3. Preventive services: Supporting children from low-income families, single-parent families, families of foreign countries, mothers in prison...



Preschool Daycare

The preschoolers come to our center Monday through Friday from 8 am till 3:30 pm. With diverse curriculum, the children are supported to learn with the preschoolers from our neighboring kindergarten at least once a week, hoping that the children we serve will develop in every aspect.

- 1. Age Range: from 2.5yrs to 6yrs who are developmentally delayed or disabled.
- 2. Service Model: day-care, small group teaching, plus one on one teaching, team teaching, etc.
